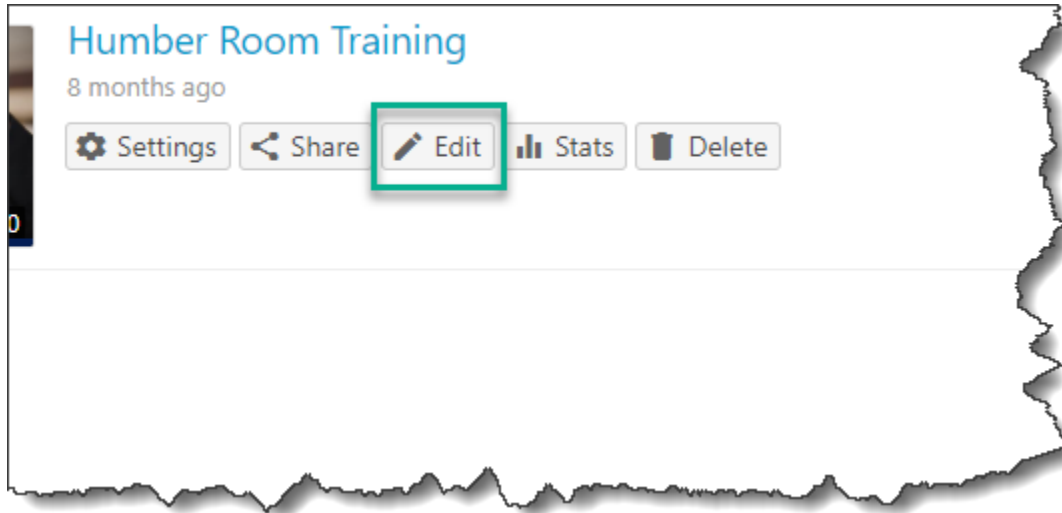


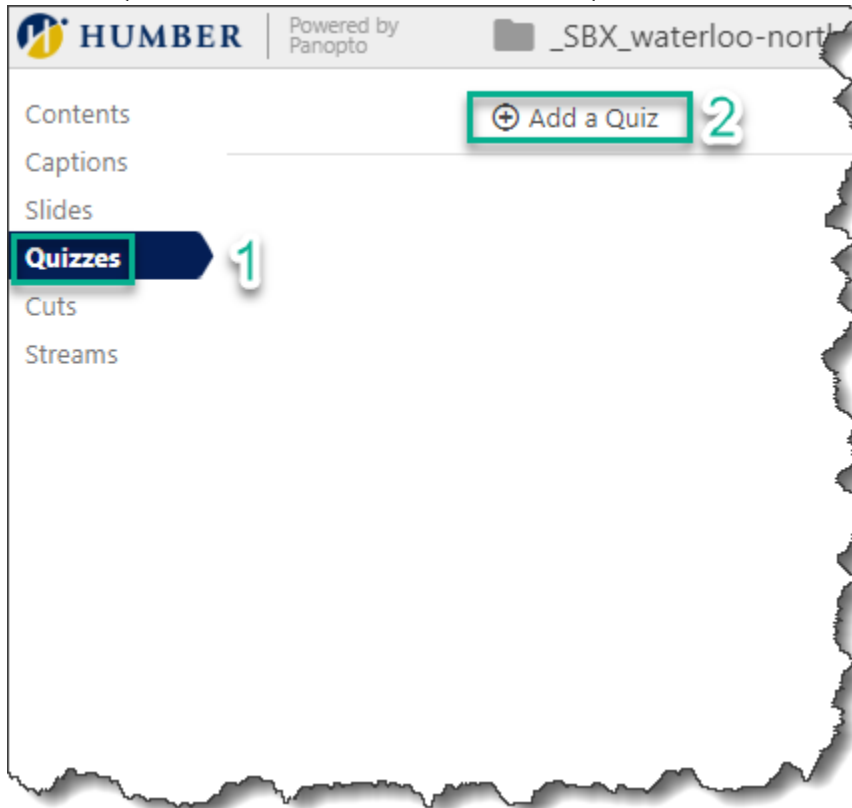
Inserting a Panopto Quiz in BB

STEP 1: Set up the quiz in Panopto.

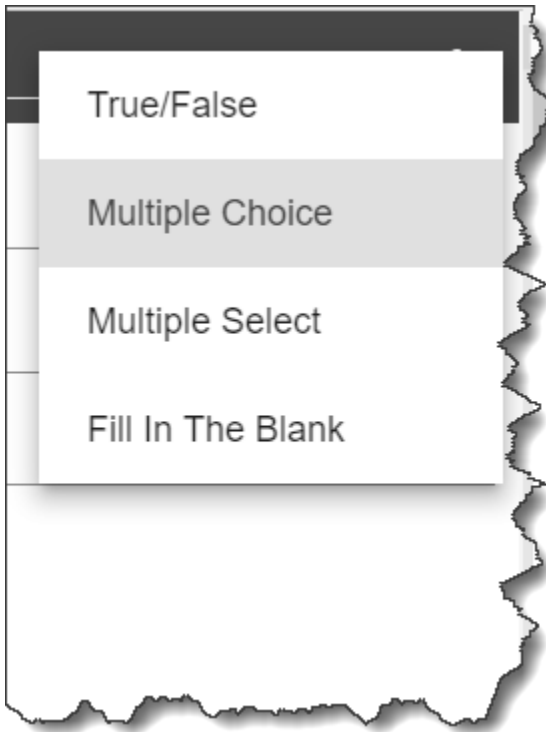
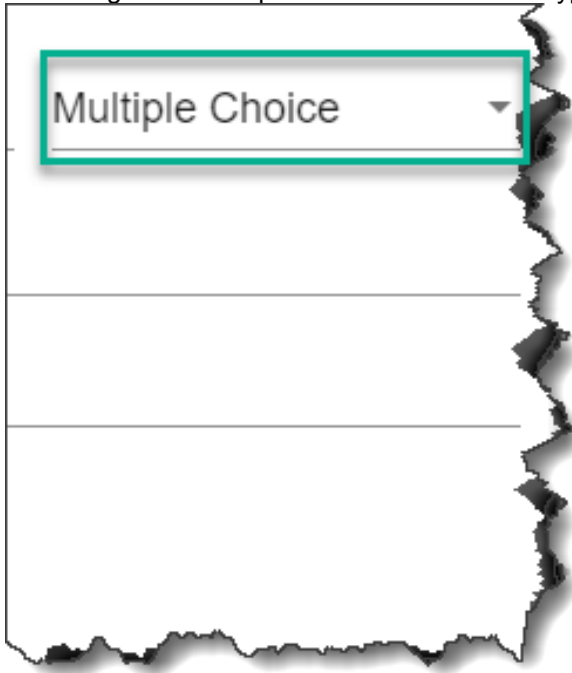
1. Hover over the video. Click on **Edit**.




2. Go to the point of time (in the video) that you want to add questions.
3. Click on **Quizzes** in the sidebar. Click on **Add a Quiz**.



4. On the right-hand drop-down menu select the type of question you want to add.




5. Fill in the question details. Set the correct answer. Select **Done**.

 - a. Enter a **Question Title**. Without a title the question will not be created.
 - b. Enter a **question** with underscores to the left and right of words that the student is to fill in. For example: “_color_” in the question *The sky is the color blue*). A preview of your question appears below.

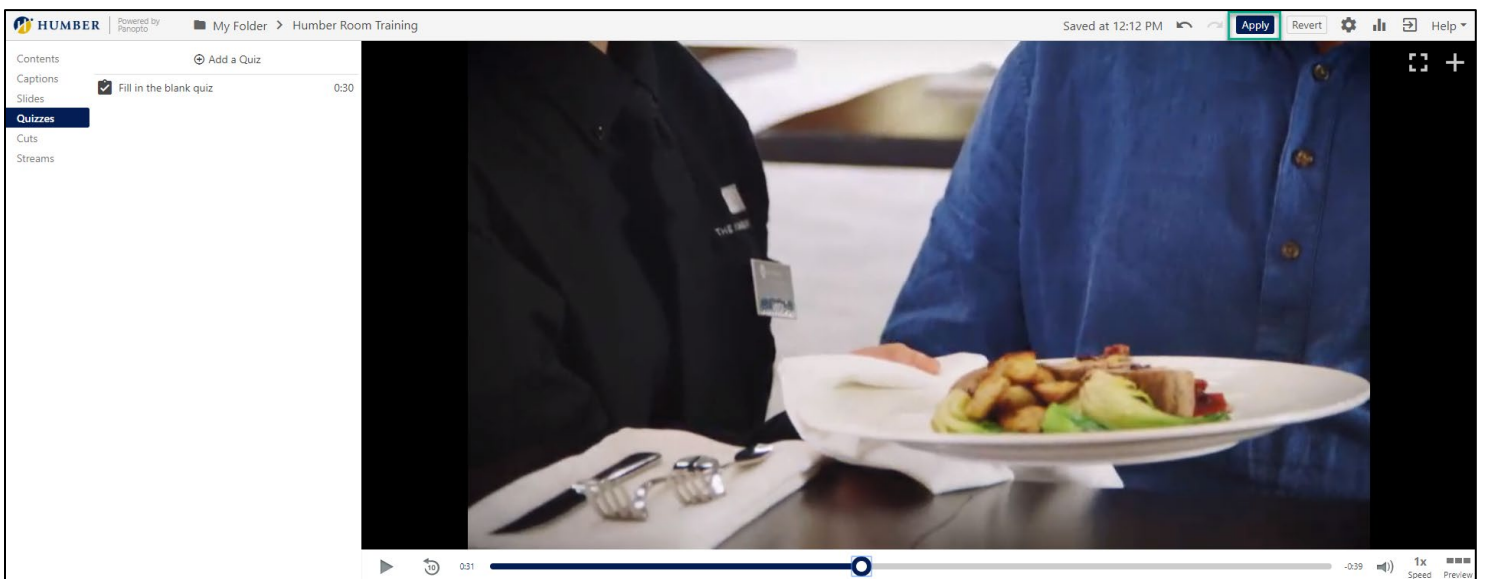

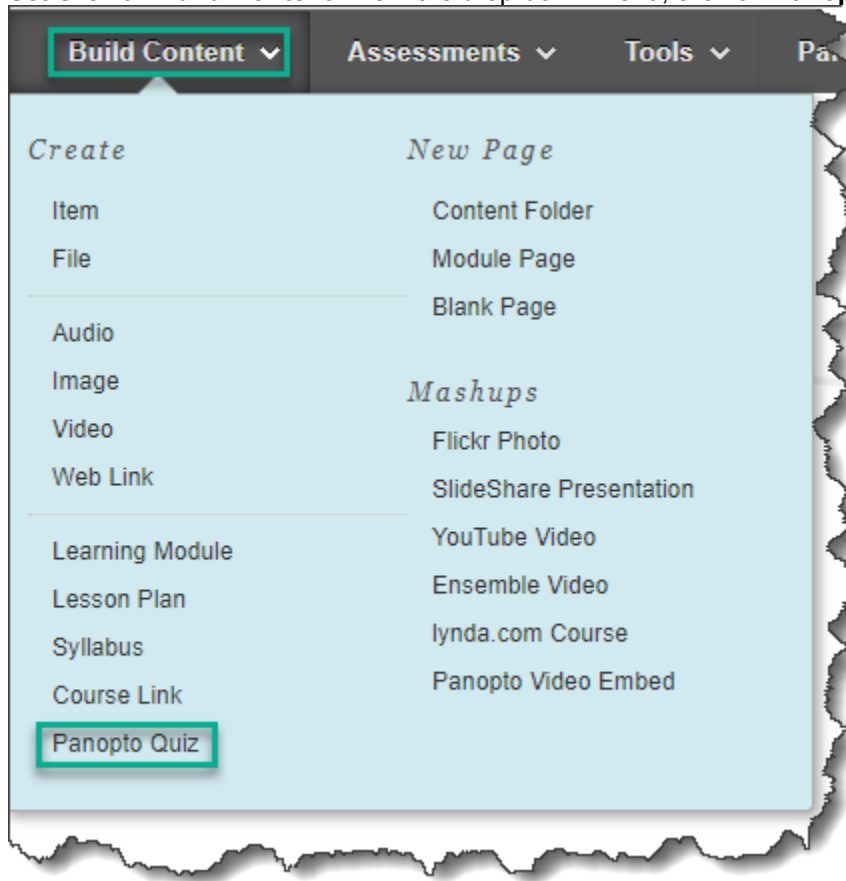

11. To ensure the changes made are saved, select **Apply** on the toolbar above the video,



STEP 2: Link the quiz to Blackboard.

1. Set Click on **Build Content**. From the drop-down menu, click on **Panopto Quiz**.




2. Enter **Name** and **Description** (optional).



Note: If you have more than one quiz in a video, set the **Points Possible** to the sum of all the points in the video. (e.g. if Quiz 1 is 5 points and Quiz 2 is 6 points, then set Points Possible to 10). A Panopto Quiz links only one grade column to the Full Grade Center per video.

4. Set **Permit Users to View this Content** and **Track Number of Views** to **Yes**.

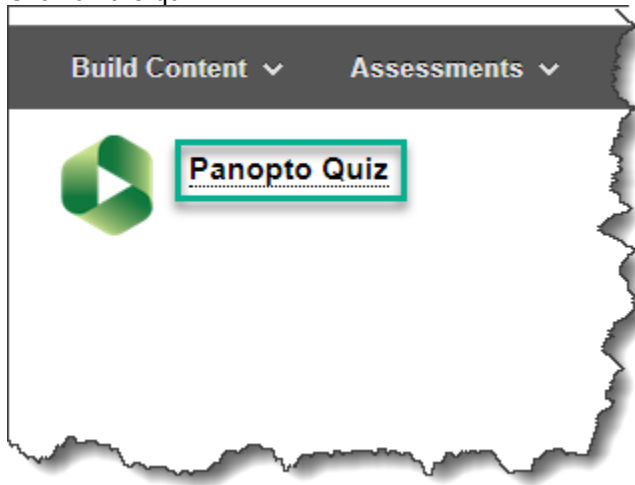

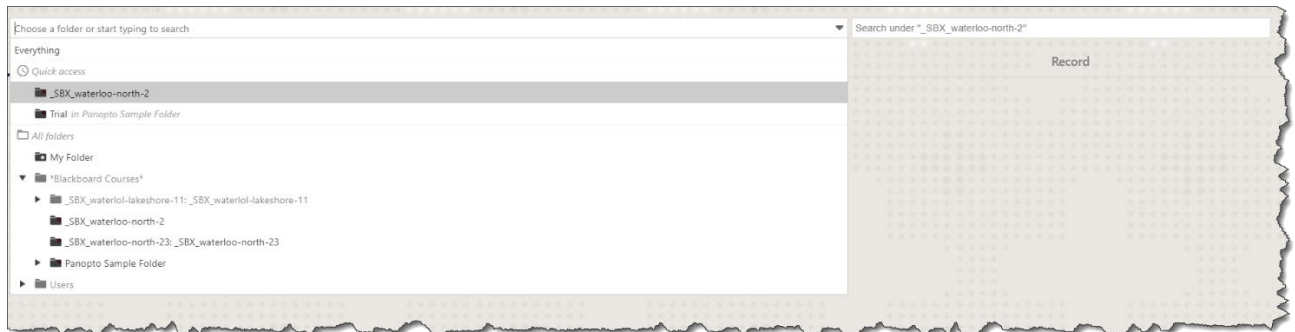
5. Click **Submit**.

STEP 3: Attach video in Panopto to quiz in Blackboard.

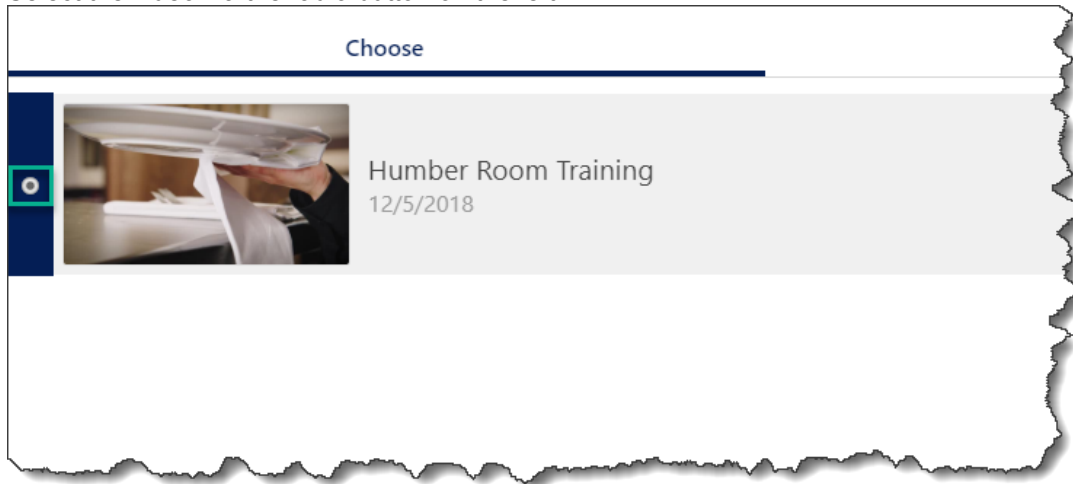
1. Click on the quiz link in BB.



2. From the drop-down menu, navigate to the folder that contains the video with the quiz. You can also search for videos within folders or Everything using the search bar next to the drop-down menu.



3. Select the video via the radio button on the left.



4. Click **Insert**.

GRADES:

Based on the percentage of correct answers the student submits via the quiz in Panopto, this determines the corresponding percentage of the score that the student will receive via Blackboard. You can view students' scores through **Full Grade Center**.
