

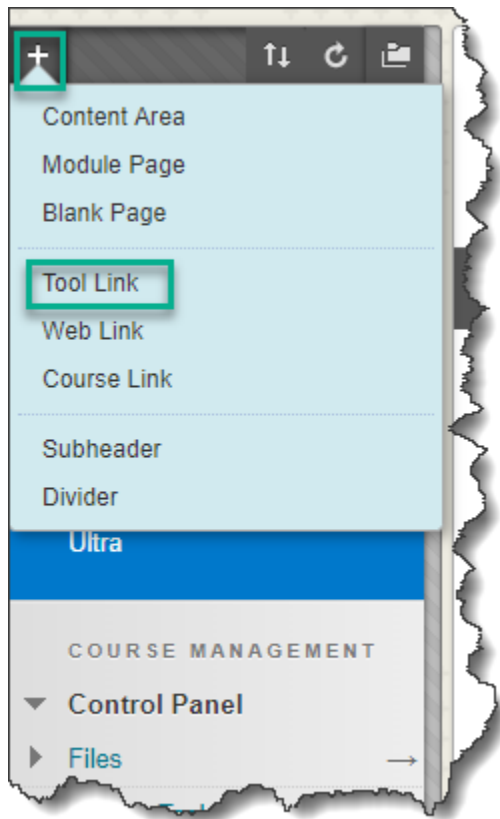
Embedding a Panopto Video in Blackboard

Embedding is a good way to share a video with your students. When you embed a video, your student can play the video directly within Blackboard, without having to click on additional links.

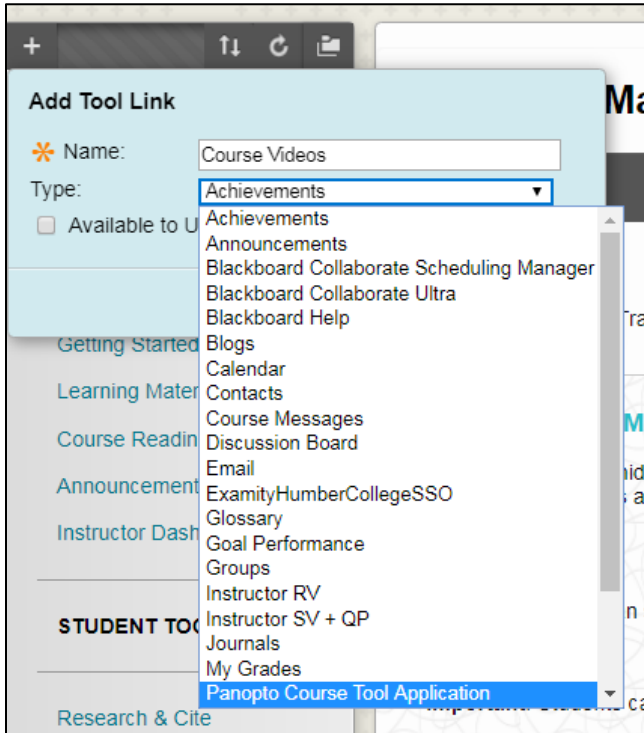
Note: Before you begin using Panopto in Blackboard, you will need to provision your course. Follow the instructions in the Provision Course job aid

Provision your course

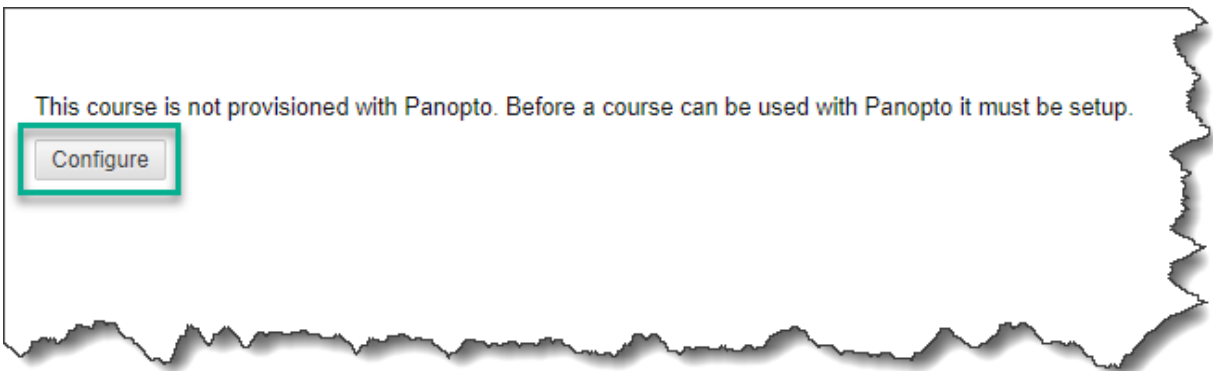
1. Click on the plus, + sign on the left-hand side. Click Tool Link.



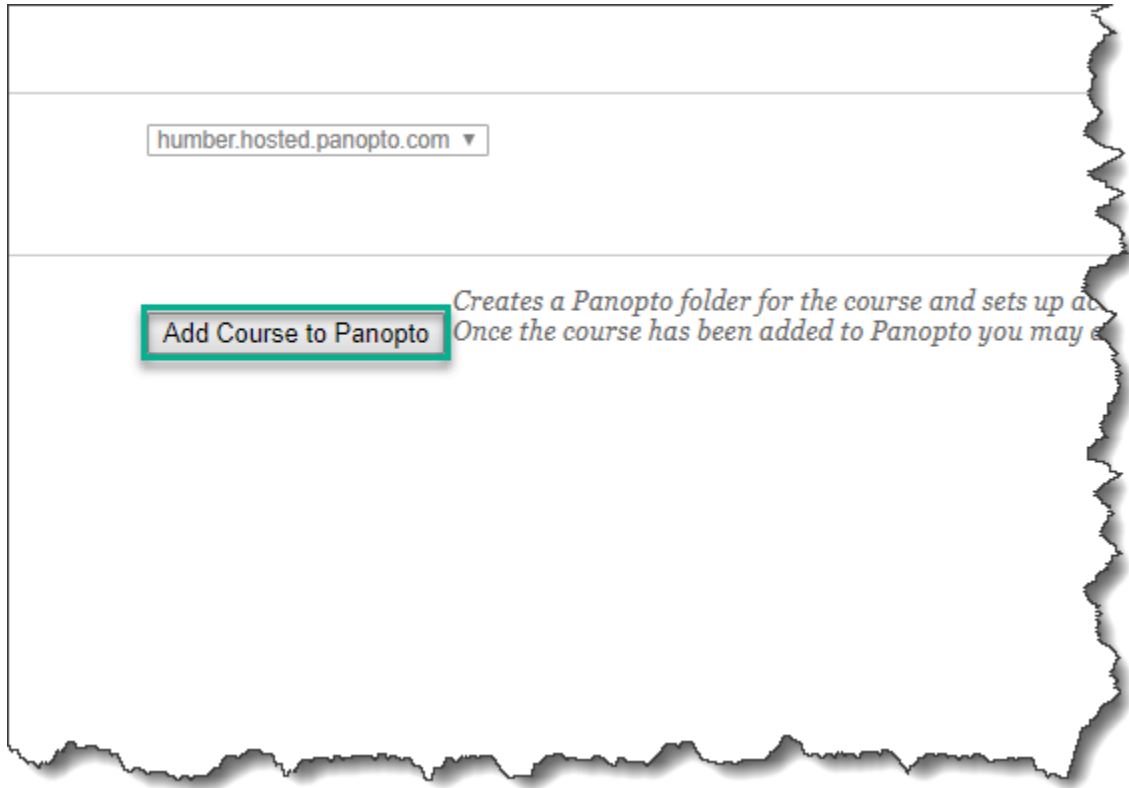
- From the dropdown menu, select Panopto Course Tool Application. Enter a name such as Panopto Videos or Course Videos then click on Submit.




- Click on Configure.



4. Click Add Course to Panopto.



To check that your course was successfully provisioned with Panopto, check for the following:

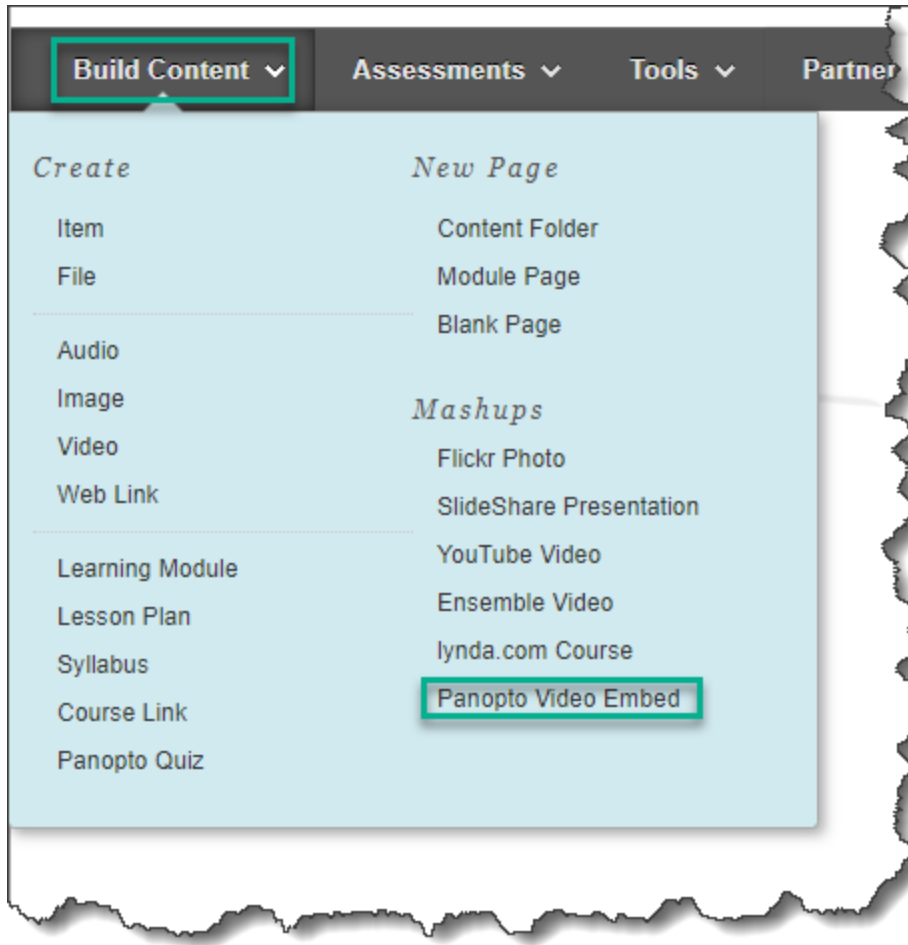
Your course is now provisioned with Panopto. Click on Return to course.

5. This process will create a link in the sidebar that is not visible to students. Its purpose is so you can embed videos or playlists into Blackboard.

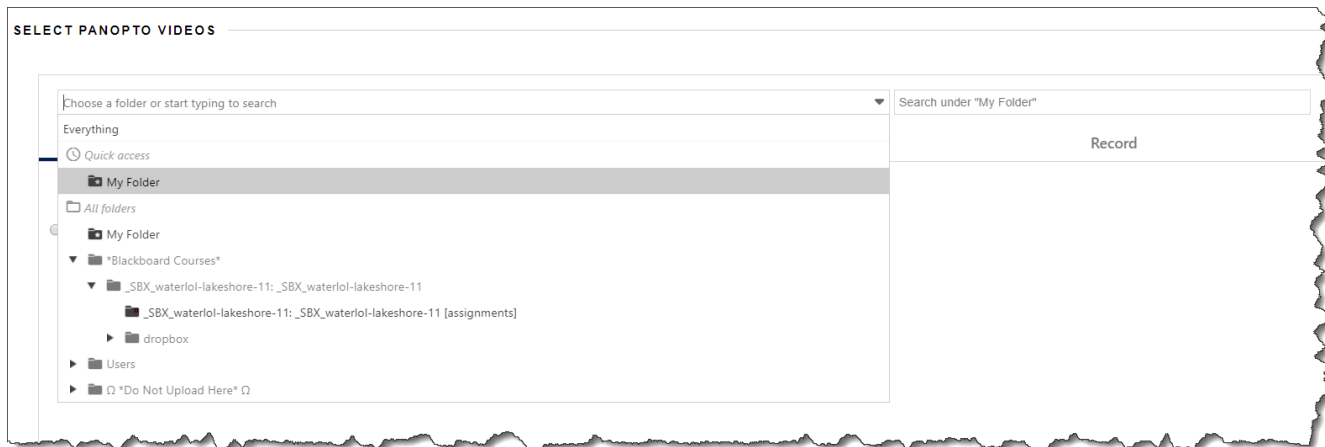
Embed a video or playlist

Go to the relevant section of your Blackboard course.

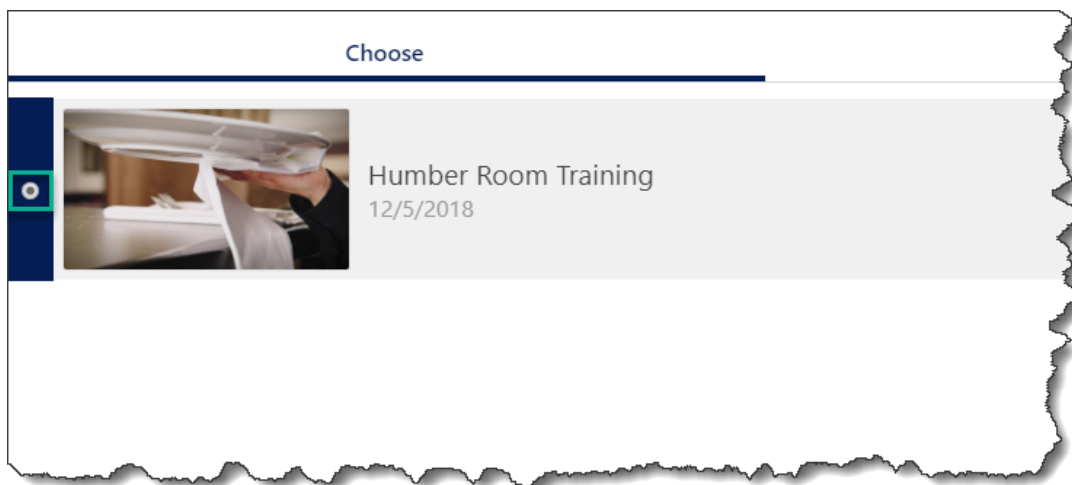
1. Click on **Build Content**. From the drop-down menu, under *Mashups*, click on **Panopto Video Embed**.



- From the drop-down menu, navigate to the folder that contains the video you want to share with your students. You can also search for videos within folders or Everything using the search bar next to the drop-down menu.



- Select the video via the radio button on the left.



- Click **Insert Video**.

Your Panopto video is now embedded into Blackboard.
