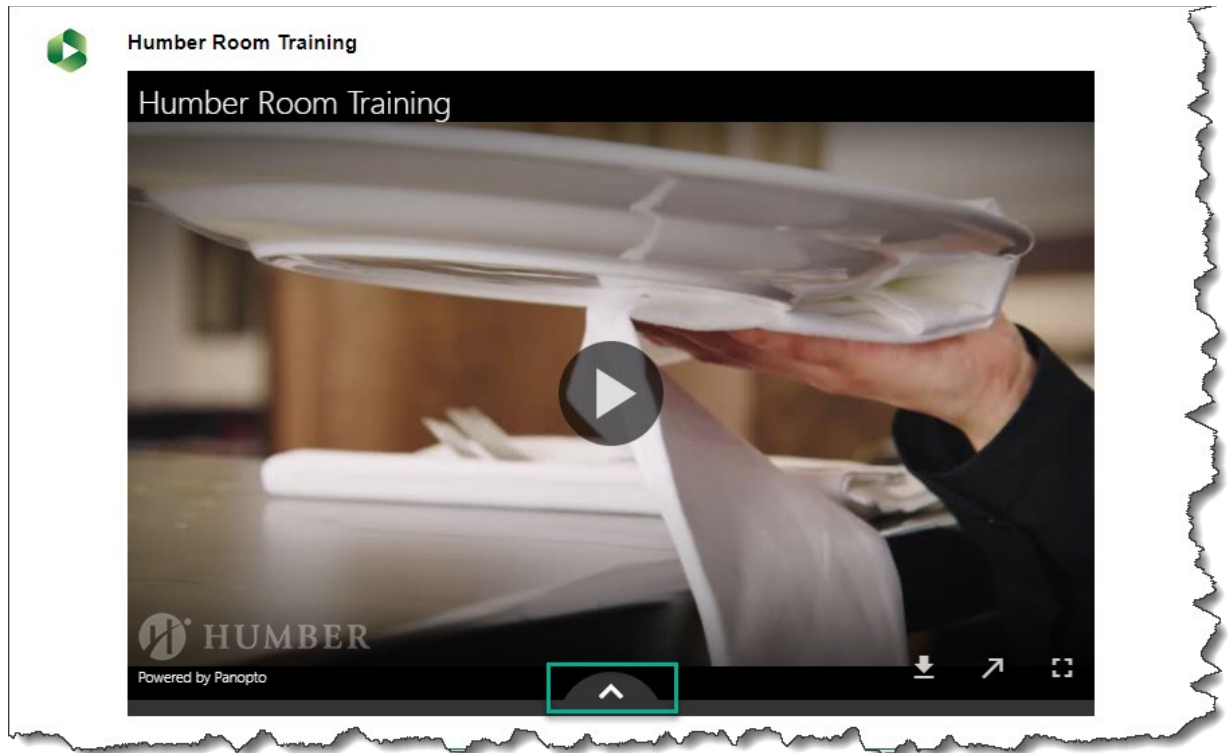


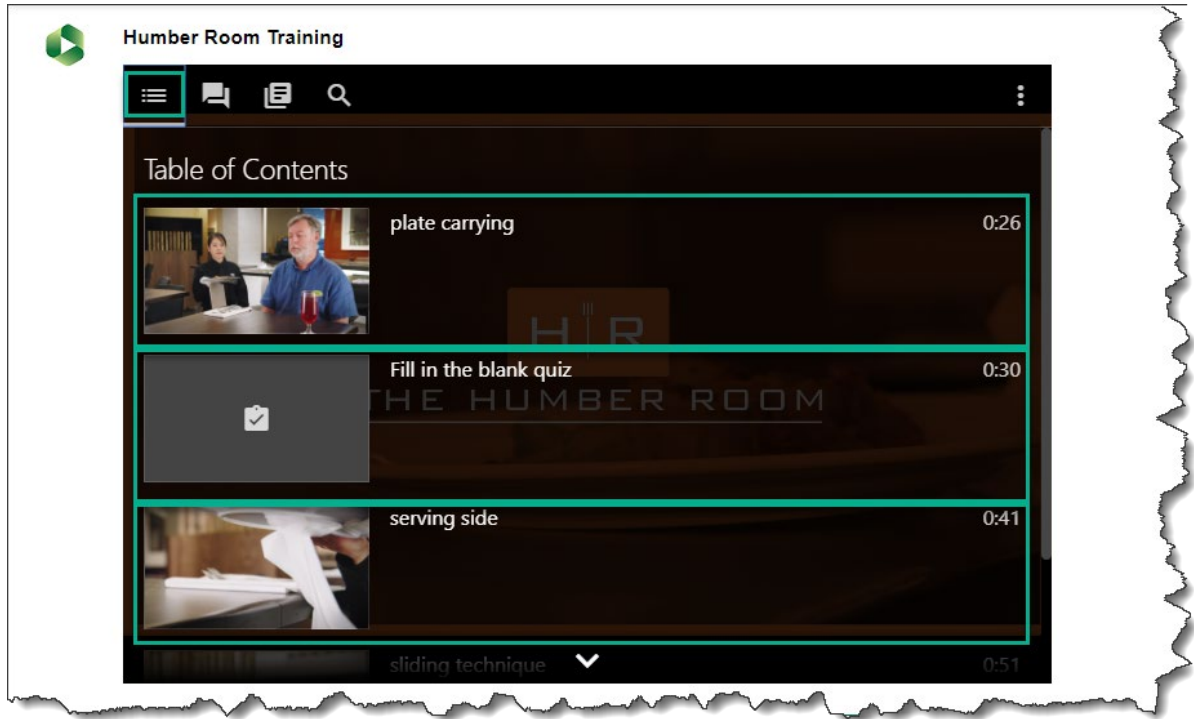
Panopto's Embedded Video Player Tools

Embedding is the best way to share a video with your students. Embedded videos now display the Panopto tools that enhance the user experience. These tools include: table of contents, discussion comments, notes and search.

To view the Panopto tools within the player, select the **upwards-arrow** in the dark grey bottom row.



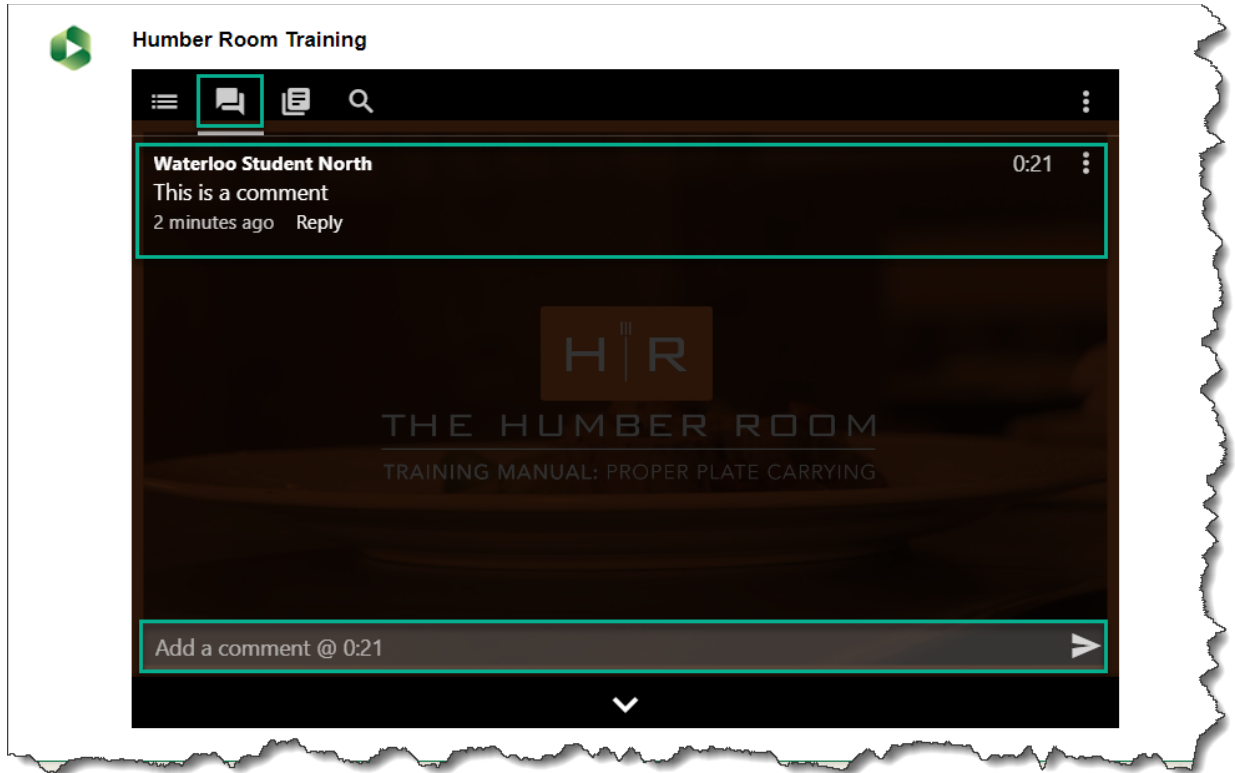
1. Select the **Table of Contents** icon (a bulleted list) to view the video's table of contents if available. Select items within the table of contents to jump to specific time stamps throughout the video.



2. Select the **Comments** icon (chat bubbles) to view and post comments throughout the video. Use the text box to post a comment. You can select a comment to view the relevant section of the video.

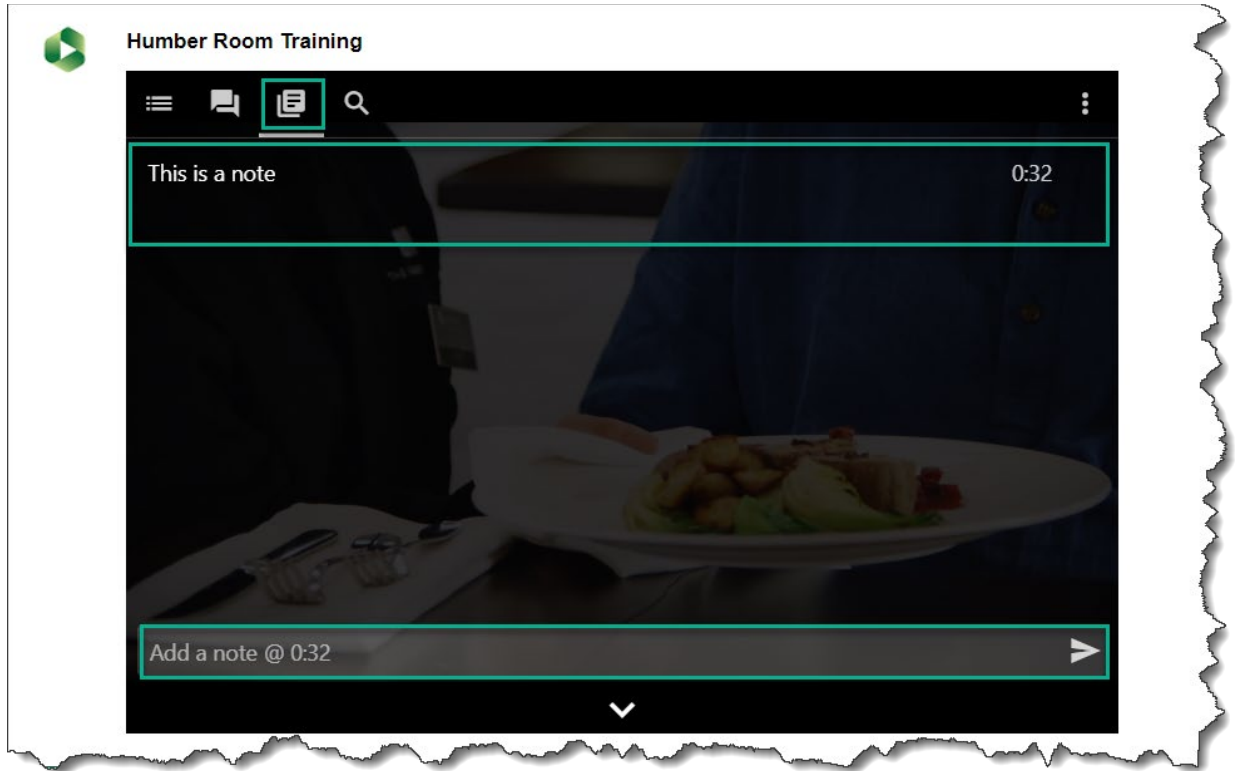
Comments can be viewed by everyone that has access to the video.

Note: Dedicate hashtags to use within comments or notes to make it easier for students to search for specific content.



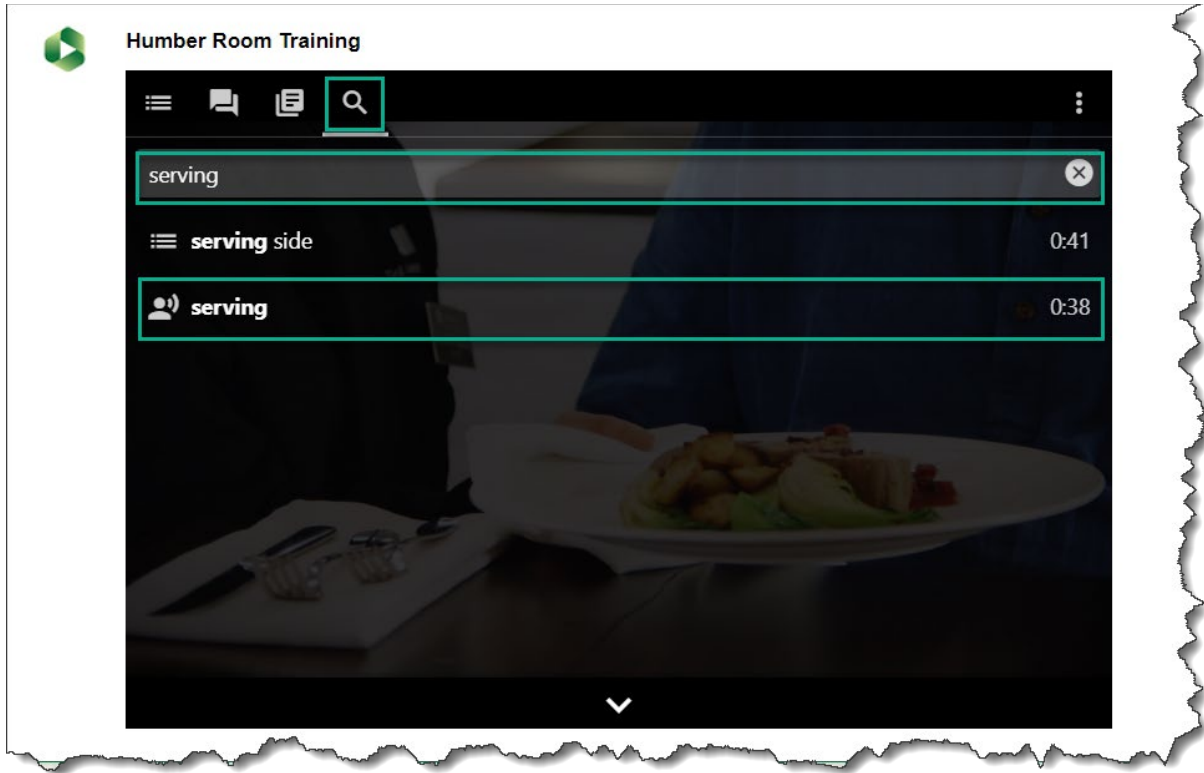
3. Select the **Notes** icon (lines on paper) to view and post notes throughout the video. Use the text box to post a note. You can select a note to view the relevant section of the video.

By default, notes are private and can only be viewed by the creator.



4. Select the **Search** icon (a magnifying glass) to search for keywords or phrases within the video as well as within the comments and notes. You can select an item from the results to view the relevant section of the video.

Note: Results from the Panopto tools are identified by unique icons.



Note: To hide the Panopto tools, select the **downwards-arrow** in the dark grey bottom row.
